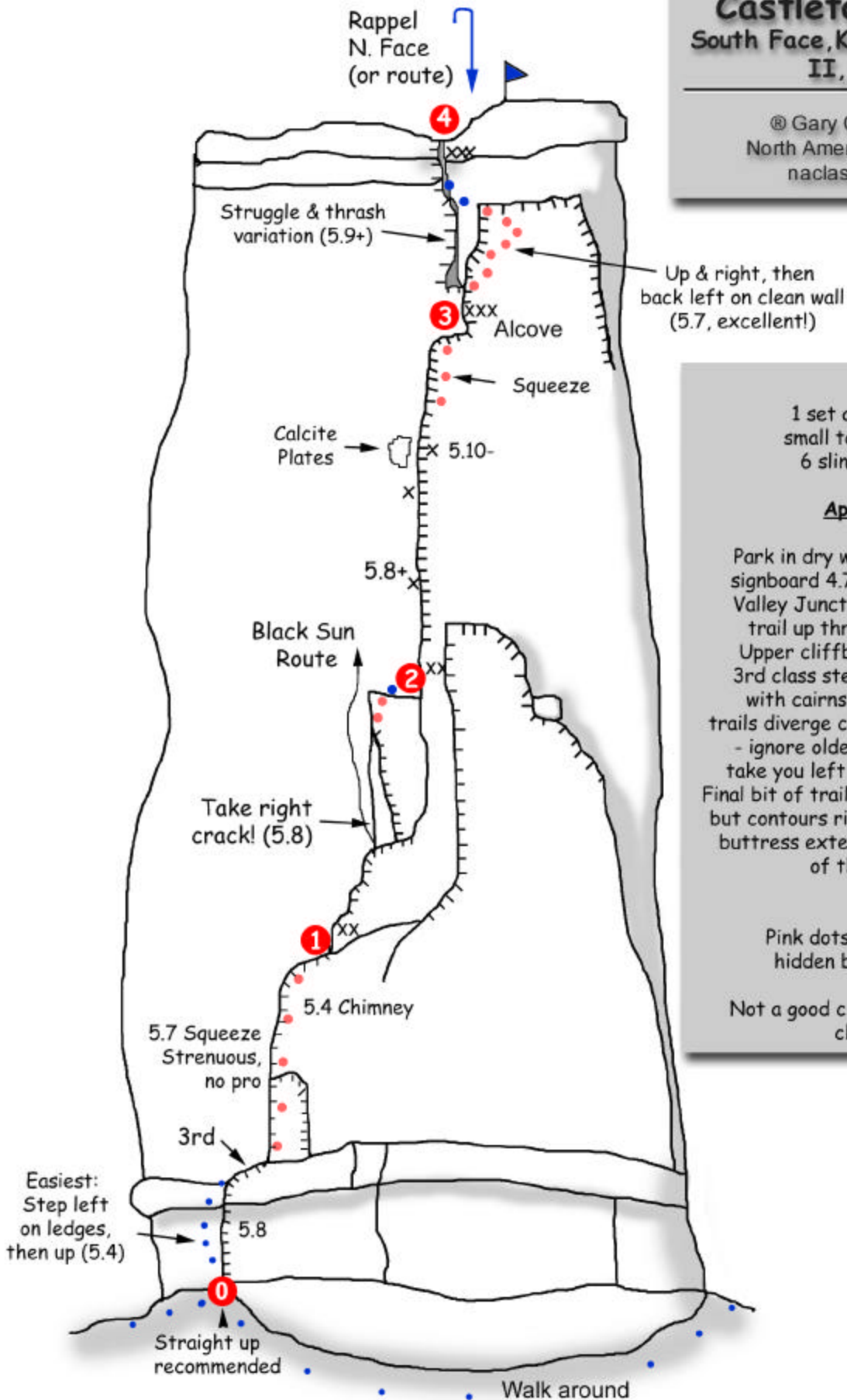


Castleton Tower

South Face, Kor/Ingalls Rte. II, 5.9+

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Rack:

1 set active cams,
small to #4 Camalot
6 slings, 6 draws

Approach:

Park in dry wash with trailhead signboard 4.7 miles from Castle Valley Junction. Hike developed trail up through cliff bands. Upper cliffband requires 15ft 3rd class steep section, marked with cairns. Keep right when trails diverge close to base of tower - ignore older descriptions that take you left to the North side! Final bit of trail is not well developed, but contours right around the small buttress extending from the base of the route.

Pink dots indicate route hidden behind feature.

Not a good choice for beginning climbers!
